JOB OPPORTUNITY

Open Call on competitive basis at the **FUNDACIÓN PARA LA INVESTIGACION BIOMÉDICA DEL HOSPITAL CLÍNICO SAN CARLOS-IdISSC** for a position as **Study Coordinator** (in accordance with collective agreement: Área 2 – Grupo III – Titulado Medio or Área 2 – Grupo II – Titulado Superior) at the Cardiology Unit, for the following project funded by Horizon 2020 Work Programme: “SECURE”.

Full-time contract (37.5 hours per working week).

The starting date will be immediately after call closure and the duration of the contract will until 31st December 2021 approximately or when funds allocated to this project are completely expended or the end of the project. Gross salary per year 22.198€ or 25.729.5 € according to candidate value and in accordance with Spanish Law.

JOB DESCRIPTION/RESPONSABILITIES

- Assist the Principal Investigators of the assigned sites for the collection and introduction of data in the eCRF; coordination of patient visits and procedures; Prepare monitoring visits (request medical records, enter data from source documents in the eCRF, source documents maintenance) and attend to the monitor during monitoring visits and when required; Facilitate communication between the Sponsor (monitor, data entry, pharmacovigilance, etc.) and the Investigator team, being the link between them; Ensure compliance with the Protocol, GCPs and current legislation; Coordinate appointments with the trial monitors; Resolve discrepancies (queries); Comply with database interim analysis; Inform the Sponsor of Serious Adverse Events in time (24 hours); Attend the Investigators Meetings.

EDUCATION AND TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

- At least Bachelor's Degree (EQF level 6)

SELECTION CRITERIA

Candidates will be evaluated by a designated Evaluation Committee (only if they meet the Education and Training Requirements). This Committee will act in accordance to the following criteria:

A) Merit expertise:

1. Previous experience as a data entry or related responsibilities in clinical research (0-3)
2. Experience in coordinating clinical trials (0-3)
3. Administrative, methodological and computer knowledge. (0-2)
4. English fluent (0-1)
5. Mobility (0-1)

B) Job Interview (only if you overcome 5 points at A) Merit Expertise. Previous labour mobility and personal experience, including the experience obtained in non-standard or informal ways, will be assessed. (0 to 5 points)
